## Field and Shelter Activity

## FIELD SERVICES

Montgomery County Animal Care and Control provided active and on call animal control service for all areas of Montgomery County and the City of Clarksville for the fourth quarter of 2018.

## Officer Activity

For the Fourth quarter of 2018, Animal Control Officers handled 1,292 calls for service. Nearly half of all calls, (44\%) were for a stray domestic animal, normally a dog running at large. Investigations for Welfare/Neglect, Bites, Confined Stray's, Aggressive/Dangerous Dog made up for (37\%) of all calls.

## FIELD SERVICE CALLS BY ZONES

Animal Control Officers responded to 1,292 calls for service in Montgomery County with a majority of the calls, (54\%) being in the West portion of Montgomery County/City of Clarksville.


## FIELD SERVICE CALLS BY JURISDICTION

Calls for service that were responded to in Montgomery County were dispersed into the following two Jurisdictions, which covers the Montgomery County outside of the Clarksville City Limits and all unincorporated areas of the County, and within the city limits of Clarksville. (88\%) of all calls for the $4^{\mathrm{TH}}$ quarter of 2018 occurred within the city of Clarksville and (12\%) of calls for the $4^{\mathrm{TH}}$ Quarter of 2018 occurred in the unincorporated areas of Montgomery County.

## FIELD SERVICE CALLS BY ZIP CODE

Calls for service that were responded to in Montgomery County were dispersed into the following thirteen (13), which covers the Montgomery County outside of the Clarksville City Limits and all unincorporated areas of the County, and within the city limits of Clarksville. (49\%) of all calls for the $4^{\text {th }}$ Quarter of 2018 occurred within the 37042 Zip Code, which compromises the North Central portion of Montgomery County north of the Cumberland River, while (27\%) of calls occurred in Zip Code area 37040, which compromises the Northeast and South Central portion of the County


## OFFICER FIELD ACTIVITY RESULTS

Officers responded to 1,292 calls for service. In response to calls for services officer complete various forms of outcomes to close out and complete these calls ranging from warnings to written reports on the incidents.


## SHELTER AND ADOPTION SERVICES

## Kennel Visitors

The shelter saw over 5,090 people visited the shelter in the $4^{\text {TH }}$ Quarter of 2018. Most of the visitors indicated they were looking to adopt a pet or trying to locate a lost pet.

## Animals Impounded

In the $4^{T H}$ quarter of 2018 , 992 animals were impounded. Of the animals impounded, $40 \%$ were cats/kittens, $59 \%$ were dogs/puppies.

## SHELTER INTAKE REASONS

The shelter took in 996 animals in the $4^{\text {TH }}$ Quarter of 2018. A majority of those intakes, ( $80 \%$ ) were stray animals either picked up in the field or brought in over the counter. (12\%) were owner surrendered pets and the remaining (8\%) consisted of Adoption Returns, Feral Animals, Euthanasia Requests, Bite Quarantines, Protective Custody, and Abandoned Animals.

NOTE: Owner Surrenders dropped by 43\% over $3^{\text {rd }}$ quarter 2018

## Owner Surrenders

Beginning in April of 2018, we began to track the reason for owner surrenders in Montgomery County. There were 111 Owner surrenders in the $4^{\text {TH }}$ quarter, of which 62 were dogs and 62 were cats. Of those Owner Surrenders, the most prevalent reason to Owner Surrender was 1. Personal - 21\%, followed by 2. Too Many - 16\% and Housing - 14\%. Time, Owner Illness, and Behavior were other primary reasons $27 \%$

NOTE: We have seen a 65\% decrease in owner surrenders from the $2^{\text {nd }}$ quarter 2018.

## Dogs

There were 579 dogs impounded in the $4^{\mathrm{TH}}$ quarter of 2018 . $81 \%$ were strays, $11 \%$ were owner released ( $60 \%$ Decrease over $2^{\text {nd }}$ quarter), $8 \%$ were for other reasons (Quarantine, Protective Care, Confiscated), and $1 \%$ were impounded for owner requested euthanasia

## Dog Outcomes

Outcomes for dogs impounded at the shelter were primarily adoptions 38\%, returned to owner $25 \%$, and transferred to rescue 17\%. Another $13 \%$ were euthanized.
*Euthanasia of dogs decreased $24 \%$ from the $1^{\text {st }}$ Quarter

## Dog Euthanasia

Of the 61 dogs euthanized, $66 \%$ were for behavior or aggression problems that were deemed unadoptable or rescue candidates. Those problems were identified through owner reports, staff experience and interaction with the dog, shelter temperament testing, and previous bite or aggression history. Other dogs were euthanized for medical issues $14 \%$, space due to overcrowding and no available rescues or facilities to accept overflow $12 \%$ and owner requested euthanasia $8 \%$
*NOTE: Euthanasia's due to no space were reduced by $71 \%$ from the $1^{\text {st }}$ quarter.

## Cats

There were 317 cats impounded in the $4^{\text {th }}$ Quarter of 2018. 328 were strays, 62 were owner releases, and 6 were for other reasons (protective care, bite quarantine, welfare, feral). $83 \%$ of cat intakes were strays either picked up in the field or primarily brought in over the counter. $16 \%$ of our cat intakes were owner surrender (We saw a 64\% decrease in owner surrender Cats/Kittens from the $2^{\text {nd }}$ quarter).

## Cat Outcomes

Outcomes for cats impounded at the shelter were primarily for Adoption 30\% and Transferred to other shelters, rescues or Humane Societies for adoption 29\%. 27\% euthanized after intake.

NOTE: We saw a $48 \%$ decrease in euthanasia from $2^{\text {nd }}$ quarter and a $23 \%$ increase in adoptions

## Cat Euthanasia

Of the 401 cats that were impounded 105 were euthanized in the $4^{\text {th }}$ Quarter of $2018,79 \%$ of the cats were euthanized for medical reasons, primarily, infectious diseases, $11 \%$ were euthanized for behavioral or temperament problems $1 \%$ were Owner requested euthanasia.
