INTRODUCTION

The Julia M. Haynes Collection was donated by Julia M. Haynes, a member of the Tennessee Association for Family and Community Education, who amassed a collection of documents, photographs and newspaper clippings created by the organization and its members. The collection consists of approximately 150 items arranged into 3 boxes. Access to this collection may be permitted for the purposes of personal and scholarly research. SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Julia M. Haynes Collection contains approximately 150 items, consisting of documents related to the Ringgold Home Demonstration Club, which is now called the Tennessee Association for Family and Community Education. It includes documents, photographs, flyers, certificates, secretary's record books, yearbooks, and newspaper clippings created by the Tennessee Association for Family and Community Education in Ringgold, Tennessee from 1940 to 2000.

In 2003, Julia M. Haynes donated this collection. Haynes was a member of the Ringgold division of the Tennessee Association for Family and Community Education. This collection is from the Ringgold division of the Home Demonstration Club, which was founded in July 1921. Founding members include Drane, Dabney, Cunningham, Nichols, Mills, and Elliott among others. These clubs were organized by districts within Montgomery County Tennessee and held their own club meetings, organized activities, and planned events. The name of the organization has evolved over the years from the Tennessee Home Demonstration Club, Tennessee Extension Homemakers Club (E.H.C), and Tennessee Association for Family and Community Education. The Tennessee Association for Family and Community Education (F.C.E.) now consists of a network of community organizations in Tennessee. The goals of F.C.E. are to learn through shared experience, improve home and community life, strengthen adult education, and promote projects that enhance family and community life.

During the processing of this collection, all photographs were removed and housed in the Archives Photograph Collection.
