Oakland Road Realignment



Project Description:

This project improved approximately ½ mile of Oakland Road for safety and sight distance concerns. Montgomery County facilitated this project through the Right of Way acquisition phase and then the Tennessee Dept of Transportation (TDOT) combined this project with its own State Route 13 (Guthrie Hwy) widening during construction as part of the Hankook Tire plant agreement. Oakland Road now intersects with Guthrie Hwy at the Southern entrance of the Tractor Supply store and features a new traffic signal. The construction of the project began early 2017.
